Concise/diction: how precise is the message, is each word necessary, or are there unnecessary words used to “beef-up” the piece

Grammar/spelling/punctuation: sentence structure, appropriate punctuation, etc.

Idea development: does the piece move with a beginning, middle and end with organization of thought. Is the writer specific and articulate their position.

Score each candidate in each category using **5**(excellent) **4** (very good) **3** (good) **2** (okay) **1** (not so hot)
